Students wishing to follow this program must have a basic knowledge of the Akkadian and Sumerian language, and cuneiform writing. She or he must also be familiar with the history and archaeology of ancient Mesopotamia. At the end of the course the student is required to complete an MA dissertation. Faculty at the department are specialists in the history and archaeology of ancient Assyria, in the economy and society of the Old Babylonian period, and in the study of the Sumerian language and literature.
